

New North Entrance Traffic Flow for Weekends

If you **come from the north (25 mile) on the weekend**: please use the new north drive to enter the parking lot. This will eliminate competition at the light for cars approaching from the south who need to turn in. Those who have limited mobility and find the new church north entrance drop-off difficult to navigate may continue using the south drive. If you do drop off at the north entry, please pull your car as close to the left-hand curb as possible so the cars behind you can get around.

If you **come from the south (24 mile) on the weekend**: you must continue to turn into the south drive (at the traffic light). The current design of Schoenherr Road does not accommodate a legal left hand turn into the north drive, since there is no bypass lane.

Do not exit out the new one-way north drive. The parish does not have permission from Macomb County (Schoenherr is a county road) for an exit there. Improvements to the parking lot exit flow can only be made in Phase 2, since those adjustments require the old rectory to be torn down before there is enough room, to widen the exit lanes. The relief for the exit is coming!
